Start Position: Standing in shooting box facing up range with hands relaxed at sides.

Gun Ready Condition: Handgun is loaded and holstered.

Stage Procedure: Upon start signal engage targets as they become visible within the shooting area. Walls extend down to the ground and upward to infinity and beyond.
