A Little One-Handed Standard



Hand Gun Start Position: Standing in the shooting area facing down range with wrists above respective shoulders.

PCC Start Position: Standing in the shooting area facing down range.

Gun Ready Condition: Handgun loaded and holstered, PCC loaded and stock on belt.

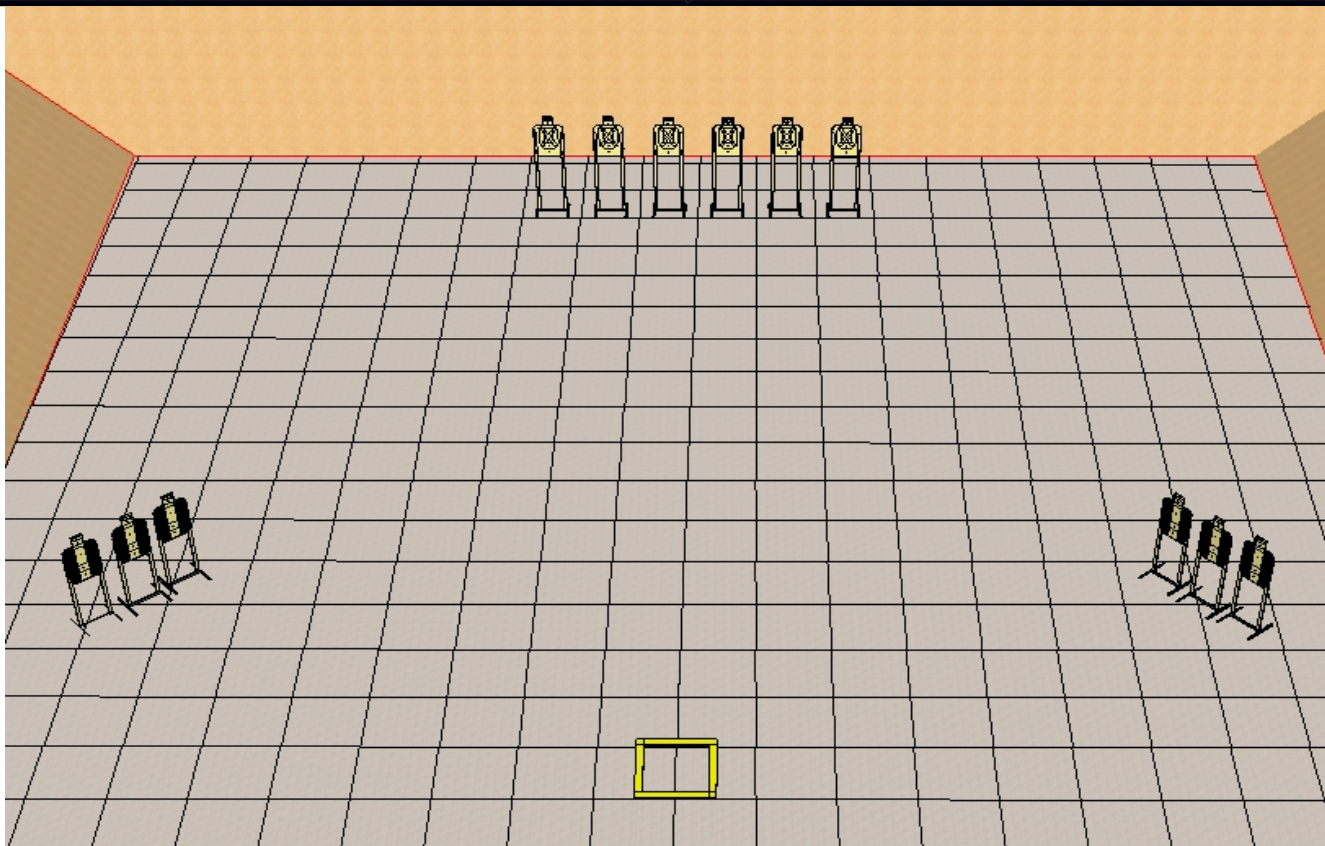
Stage Procedure:

String 1: Engage any 6 targets freestyle with one round each. Perform a mandatory reload and engage the remaining 6 targets with one round each strong hand only.

String 2: Engage any 6 targets freestyle with one round each. Perform a mandatory reload and engage the remaining 6 targets with one round each, weak hand only.

PCC :

All references to “strong hand” and “weak hand” in the current edition of the rule book apply to PCC as follows: Strong Hand will require the PCC to be shouldered on the strong hand side, trigger pulled with the strong hand. Both hands may be on the gun. Weak Hand will require the PCC to be shouldered on the weak side, trigger pulled with the weak hand. Both hands may be on the gun.
